Cooking Demonstration and Competition (aka Chickensmithing)

The long and short of it is that competitors are expected to show off their cooking skills, whether over the fire, on a grill, on a camp stove...however you want to hew your meal, we all want to see how you do it and sample some of what you're making! There is no requirement that your food be chicken and there is no requirement that your food be period. We are looking for you to show off your outdoor cooking skills over an open fire, whether than fire be at a fire pit, over a charcoal grill, or otherwise. Show us your skills and feed us!

- Demonstrators and competitors will be providing the rolling day board for the event on Saturday.
- Most of the dish should be cooked on site and will be asked to explain their cooking techniques and demonstrate to onlookers.

- Cooks will be given a \$20 stipend to reimburse for expenses/supplies (limited to the first 10 cooks to sign up). Receipts are required!
- Feel free to collaborate or ask to be paired up with another cook.
- Charcoal and wood will be provided. Please feel free to bring your own supplies if you have them.

Pre-10:00 am

Watch as Lu An-hua, Ysmay de Lynn, and Lissa Underhill demonstrate the start of the pottery firing process.

10:00-11:00 am

Making and Firing Primitive Pottery. Lu An-hua, Ysmay de Lynn, and Lissa Underhill. Learn how early potters found and processed clay, formed pottery by hand, and fired pottery in a pit or bonfire.

11:15 - 12:15 pm

Understanding How to Start a Fire and the Helps and Hinderances. Lord Aiden Underhill. Tricks of the trade in building, starting, and maintaining fires.

12:15 - 1:15 pm

Break/Lunch. Day board is rolling, so feel free to eat at any time. We encourage you to tour the cooks' stations.

1:15 - 2:15 pm

Flora and Fauna of Period Embroidery. Dame Elizabet Marshall. Join Elizabet for a quick overview of ways that plants and animals (and bugs, oh my) were used in pre-17th century embroidery. Not an exhaustive class, but more like some of the highlights. This is not a hands-on class specifically, but I may have materials available for people to start their own flora or fauna motif.

Local Flora and Early Local Wild Edibles. Lady Alexondra. Hello friends! Does the prospect of green life returning to the landscape fill you with excitement? Are you looking to enjoy a bit of sunshine and take in the freshness and bounty spring has to offer? Please join me on a wild and weedy wander during The Walking of the Salamander to explore the local flora and take a look at the early wild edibles we may encounter during this beginner's foraging class. SCA Equestrian Activities - Beck of Copeland

 \mathcal{A} t some SCA events you will see colorfully-attired riders and horses charging at one another with lances, or taking part in the games of skill that squires and other mounted warriors practiced in the medieval period to build the skills needed for mounted combat and hunting. Equestrian activities enhance the medieval pageantry at our events!

SCA equestrian activities include mounted games, such as:

- Quintain practice for jousting by aiming with a lance at a shield on a rotating arm. If you have seen the movie A Knight's Tale, you have seen the quintain!
- Ring Lance uses a lance to hit rings mounted on a post.
- Tent pegging uses a spear to hit a ground target, as though riding through an enemy camp and uprooting their tent pegs.
- ➤ Heads knocking "fake" heads off posts with a sword.

Other activities you may see at an event are jousting and archery from horseback. Often the games are combined to form a course for the rider to perform, and sometimes teams of riders are needed to do all of the activities. These games allow the riders to display their historic gear and horse costumes, and make an SCA event feel as though you are attending a real medieval tournament.

To participate in equestrian activities, you must be individually authorized at riding, mounted games, and mounted archery. All authorized riders are encouraged to wear riding helmets, and all youth riders **must** wear a helmet.

Don't have a horse? You can still participate! Making game equipment or barding (garb for horses) is a great way to enhance your sewing, leather, or woodworking skills. At equestrian events, people to serve as ground crew are always needed to help reset targets and assist the riders. Ground crew is a great way to get introduced to our activities! If you don't have experience with horses and want to learn, start by asking equestrians if you can pet or hold their horse, and helping with feed and clean-up after the horse is also a great way to get to know the horses and owners. And of course, spectators are also highly encouraged.
