Court Report from Bhakail Champions and Commons

Ind so it was that on the third day of September, in the fourth year of His reign, reckoned also as the 58th year of the Society or the 2023rd year of the Common Era, Master Muin maqq Minain, the Baron of Bhakail, gathered with His people for a Commons celebration and selection of His combattant Champions in the fields at Ridley Creek.

When His Excellency drew together His Court, He called for his Baronial Armored Champion, Lady Motte Nachfalter. He spoke of her drive pursuing the Tourney to decide His Champion, and He noted that, at the time of her success, a scroll commemorating such was not available. Thus He presented to her a scroll which she, unbeknowing of the outcome of the tourney beforehand, had written herself, and which had been calligraphed and illuminated by the Honorable Lady Mairi Crawford. And so it was that He accepted the regalia of the office from her with His thanks, and released her.

Then Baron Muin summoned the Honorable Lord Guillame du Chantier and, praising his skill in the armored lists, offered him a place in Court as the Baronial Armored Champion of Bhakail, to which that worthy acceded. In recognition whereof, a document was created by Margarette la Gantière to confirm such.

That business concluded, His Excellency recognized in absence Bhakail's Populace Armored Champion, Hopwel maqq Fosgan, for his service to the Barony and released him from service.

Next, the Honorable Lord Aaron the Swift was called before the Salamander Throne. Baron Muin spoke of His conversations with those who took the armored combat field that day and, upon general agreement, asked if Aaron would take a

place in Court as the new Populace's Armored Champion, and so it was done. This business was noted with a scroll crafted by Margarette la Gantière.

His Excellency called then for His Baronial Rapier Champion, Don James O'Galleghure of Tyr Connal. Don James described the tourney held to determine who would next carry the cloak and baldric, and returned those same items of regalia that he had borne. Don James was thanked for his dedication to the Barony and set back among the people.

Upon that moment, His Excellency called for Baron Eliyahu al-Talhi, who upon the completion of the rapier tourney was found to be the most suited to serve as Baronial Rapier Champion for Bhakail. He praised the latter's prowess and offered him regalia and a place in Court and had deed recorded as done with a page crafted by Margarette la Gantière.

In her absence, His Excellency next offered thanks to Mistress Lissa Underhill for her service in the office of Populace's Rapier Champion. Mistress Lissa was released from her obligation with the Barony's appreciation.

The herald then called for Master Lorenzo Gorla, who was highly praised that day by those who competed in the rapier lists. With such recognition undeniable, His Excellency found it right and proper that Master Lorenzo be offered a place in His Court, to serve as the Populace's Rapier Champion. And so it was that Margarette la Gantière had calligraphed a document, and it was illuminated by Dame Ysmay de Lynn, that recognized that such a thing had been done. At that time, Baron Muin confirmed to Master Lorenzo was not a frog, and should not then nor ever again believe that he was a frog.

Baron Muin next had brought before him Lord Malcolm MacLeod, of the neighboring Shire of Caer Adamant. Lord Malcolm had arranged to provide poles and ropes and those things needed to mark out the lists. Not wishing such generosity to go unnoticed, His Excellency gave him a Flame, a Baronial service token.

The Baron then called for His event steward that day, Lady Chana Freidl the Maker, and spoke of how such a day would not have come to pass without her labors. That all may know she bore His appreciation for such an effort, His Excellency offered her a Flame in recognition thereof.



The Honorable Lady Mairi Crawford was called forth by the herald and presented herself to the Salamander Throne. Though Baron Muin spoke briefly of her breaking a blade in noble combat with a worthy opponent, that was not the act with which He had her attend Him. He praised her work as Baronial Signet, crafting and creating herself and organizing the crafting and creating by others of those documents, scrolls, and other recognitions which attested to the prowess and worthiness of His people. Her work accomplished, and the office settled in another's hands, Mairi was released from further obligation with great appreciation, and given recognition of her own with a Flame from His hand.

And at that time, with all business of the moment accomplished, Baron Muin maqq Minain closed His Court and walked among His people, greeting them again and offering words of thanks and appreciation for those who came and those who served. Thus it was at the conclusion of these events that I recorded them here as I saw them, and thus it is that I present them to you.


